Ms. Maya gave presentation on the 2018-2019 Budget & Fiscal Year End Report for the Town of Mesilla.

Mayor Barraza stated revenues were higher than projected with the exception of Fines and Forfeitures which was at 59.19% of projected budgeted amount.

Mayor Pro Tem Caro stated we need to be careful and prioritize how funds are spent such as when purchasing the trucks as we do not know what emergency may arise.

37 Mayor Barraza agrees spending needs to be done carefully but we currently have to spend on truck 38 repairs weekly. We will be paying for the new vehicles instead of constant repairs. There are 39 emergencies that have risen but the good thing is we had the funds to address them. 40

41 Trustee Johnson-Burick stated she is disappointed there were costly expenditures due to the state of 42 our infrastructure. The town is seeing the benefit of the rate increases in the Enterprise Fund which is 43 making it self-sustaining. The town needs to think of the lack of safety the current vehicles were 44 presenting to the town, community and staff; making it a liability issue. Safety is most important for 45 staff and the community. 46

Mayor Barraza stated the settlement from C.D. General helped with Stonegarden and Molzen/Corbin. She gave a quick recap.
