45	to be an updating of codes for Food Trucks. This is an entire fee to the town; impact is not that
46	great. The whole thing is trash collections. We have had environmental issues in the past. He

was not privy as to how the fee was arrived at. He asked what the market charging in other 1 2 areas. This money goes to the General Fund. 3 Ms. Parra stated we need to keep in mind is that we do not charge a fee. We are keeping the 4 events family and community oriented. The fees are low and there is a discount to Mesilla 5 residents. The revenue generated is very minimal. 6 7 8 Ms. Lujan stated the trash is to be picked up by the property owner. 9 Trustee Flores stated she also felt \$200 was high but she is will to let it stay at the \$200 fee. We 10 11 can lower it if there are issues. 12 Mayor Barraza commented if we see it is not working it can be brought back to the table.
